



**Announcement of the Office of the Permanent Secretary
Ministry of Energy
Subject: No Gift Policy for the Fiscal Year B.E.2567 (2024)**

In accordance with the Cabinet's approval of the National Reform Plan on prevention and suppression of corruption and misconduct (Revised Edition) and the subsequent announcement in the Royal Gazette, stipulating that every government agency declares itself as an entity where all government officials do not accept gifts and gratuities of any kind in the performance of their duties (No Gift Policy).

This declaration is a demonstration of the commitment to resist corruption, uphold ethical values and maintain integrity in the execution of duties. It allows officials to distinguish between personal benefits and collective benefits, in line with the criteria set by the National Anti-Corruption Commission.

Therefore, the Office of the Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Energy, hereby announces the policy that executives and officials of every rank within the organization will not accept gifts and gratuities of any kind, both before and after the performance of their duties, to prevent corruption and misconduct unless receiving assets or other benefits in a fair and just manner according to the criteria established by the National Anti-Corruption Commission.

This Announcement shall be informed and strictly adhered accordingly.
